Class 4 (only) to be ridden in a snaffle bridle & no spurs allowed.

Riding Club Style Jumping offers riders the chance to prove they can ride a course of show jumps in good rhythm and with the correct riding position. The winner will be the person who rides most efficiently with impulsion and balance over a course designed to encourage a flowing round of jumping. This popular and positive competition judges both horse and rider as a combination in a way that is constructive and improving. Fences are around 85cm in height.

Rules

1. Legal Liability – Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of the event to which these rules apply, nor the British Horse Society, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, vehicle or their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
2. The event is organised in accordance with the Health & Safety Legislation and all who have control of the premises or site at the event are responsible for ensuring that everything reasonably practicable is done to ensure the health and safety and welfare of those attending the event. They conduct themselves to that they do not put themselves or anyone else at risk. Access to and egress from the site is safe. Booklet, if required, stating Health & Safety rules, available at Secretary's tent. Emergency services must have access to all parts of the event site at all times.
3. Competitors must be correctly dressed for the event. Hats to new standards EN1384 or PAS015 must be worn at all times when mounted. Hat prefixed with either SEI or ASRM are the American standards and are also acceptable. Body/back protectors are compulsory for cross country. Correct footwear must be worn.
4. Saddlery: Dressage according to British Dressage rules. Showjumping according to BSJA rules except Market Harboroughs are not allowed. Whips allowed in both dressage and showjumping, whips are not to exceed 70cm/30" in SJ.
5. Callers are permitted in dressage.
6. Judges' decisions are final.
7. Any member of Bath Riding Club Committee, Judge or Steward has the right to ask any rider or persons abusing the use of whip or spurs, using ill fitting or dangerous tack or acting in an offensive manner to leave the field forfeiting all fees.
8. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry, cancel classes, divide or amend any class or restrict the number of entries in any class.
9. No Horse/Pony under the age of 4 years may compete.
10. All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
11. Parking is on the competition field ONLY. Competitors are asked NOT to park in the private car park adjoining the entrance.
