Ring 1 Commencing at 9.30am (Run under BSJA rules)

- Class 1** **Open jumping** – Fences approx 2ft 3” Table A7
(Restricted to first 45 entries)
- Class 2** **Open Jumping** – Fences approx 2ft 6” Table A7
(Restricted to first 45 entries)
- Class 3** **Pairs Jumping** – Fences approx 2ft 6” One round against the clock
(Restricted to first 20 entries, £12 per pair)

The following classes will not commence before 1pm

- Class 4** **Open Jumping** – Fences approx 2ft 9” Table A7 (Restricted to first 45 entries)
- Class 5** **Open Jumping** – Fences approx 3ft” Table A7

Ring 2 Commencing at 9.00am Clear round and minimus SJ classes

Clear Round starting at 1ft 9” approx, raised throughout the day.
£2.50 a round. Rosettes to all clear rounds.

12noon

- Class 6** **Restricted Novice** not to have been placed 1st to 3rd in any jumping competition. Fences approx 1ft 9”. May be led. (Table A7)
- Class 7** **Novice jumping** – not to have won more than £15 in any jumping competition. Fences approx 2ft”. May be led. (Table A7)

Clear round will continue after Class 7

All classes - Rosettes to 6th place, trophy to winner

Entry fees Classes 1,2, 4, 5, 6, 7: Advance entries (received by Saturday 26th April 2008) £6 members, £8 non members. Entries on the day £1 extra per class.
Class 3 - £12 per pair. Add £2 per rider towards Paramedic cover

Clear Round Cross Country Commencing at 10am
£6 a round members, £8 a round non members (rosettes to all clear rounds) All entries taken on the day
Cross Country fences range from 2ft 3 to 3ft

Rules

1. Legal Liability – Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of the event to which these rules apply, nor the British Horse Society, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, vehicle or their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
2. The event is organised in accordance with the Health & Safety Legislation and all who have control of the premises or site at the event are responsible for ensuring that everything reasonably practicable is done to ensure the health and safety and welfare of those attending the event. They conduct themselves to that they do not put themselves or anyone else at risk. Access to and egress from the site is safe. Booklet, if required, stating Health & Safety rules, available at Secretary's tent. Emergency services must have access to all parts of the event site at all times.
3. Competitors must be correctly dressed for the event. Hats to new standards EN1384 or PAS015 must be worn at all times when mounted. Hat prefixed with either SEI or ASRM are the American standards and are also acceptable. Correct footwear must be worn. Back protectors are compulsory for cross country.
4. Judges' decisions are final.
5. Any member of Bath Riding Club Committee, Judge or Steward has the right to ask any rider or persons abusing the use of whip or spurs, using ill fitting or dangerous tack or acting in an offensive manner to leave the field forfeiting all fees.

6. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry, cancel classes, divide or amend any class or restrict the number of entries in any class.
7. No Horse/Pony under the age of 4 years may compete.
8. All dogs must be kept on leads.
9. Parking is on the competition field ONLY. Competitors are asked NOT to park in the private car park adjoining the entrance.
10. Table A7 is a two round competition. The first round is untimed and all competitors jumping clear will be invited back into the ring to jump a second timed round over a shortened course.
