

Rules

1. Legal Liability – Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of the event to which these rules apply, nor the British Horse Society, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, vehicle or their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
2. The event is organised in accordance with the Health & Safety Legislation and all who have control of the premises or site at the event are responsible for ensuring that everything reasonably practicable is done to ensure the health and safety and welfare of those attending the event. They conduct themselves to that they do not put themselves or anyone else at risk. Access to and egress from the site is safe. Booklet, if required, stating Health & Safety rules, available at Secretary's tent. Emergency services must have access to all parts of the event site at all times.
3. **Competitors must be correctly dressed for the event. Hats to new standards EN1384 or PAS015 must be worn at all times when mounted. Hat prefixed with either SEI or ASRM are the American standards and are also acceptable. Body/back protectors and medical armbands are compulsory for the event. Correct footwear must be worn.**
4. Any competitor jumping or riding over the cross country course or any part thereof except when competing in a cross country event will be asked to leave the field. All entry fees will be forfeited.
5. After three refusals at any one fence, competitors may continue but must go on to the next fence making way for any riders coming up behind.
6. Judges' decisions are final and no entry fees will be refunded unless the class is cancelled.
7. Any member of Bath Riding Club Committee, Judge or Steward has the right to ask any rider or persons abusing the use of whip or spurs, using ill fitting or dangerous tack or acting in an offensive manner to leave the field forfeiting all fees.
8. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry, cancel classes, divide or amend any class or restrict the number of entries in any class.
9. No Horse/Pony under the age of 4 years may compete.
10. All dogs must be kept on leads.
11. Parking is on the competition field ONLY. Competitors are asked NOT to park in the private car park adjoining the entrance.

WITHDRAWALS: In the event of any withdrawals, the organisers regret that they cannot refund entry fees after the close of entries

BAD WEATHER: It is the responsibility of the competitors to check with the organiser if weather is inclement.

| Class 1 | Minimus (Fences approx 1ft 6" – 2ft) May be led. Class to be split into lead rein / non-lead rein sections if sufficient entries. Please state on entry form if to be lead. |
| Class 2 | Restricted Novice (Fences approx 2ft 3")
Present combination not to have been placed 1 st , 2 nd , or 3 rd in any cross country event (including two phase, hunter trials and ODE) |
| Class 3 | Open Novice Run over the same course as Class 2a |
| Class 4 | Novice Pairs Ridden over the Novice course with Dressing Fences, Show jumping to be jumped separately with one person waiting in a box, then the XC phase will be jumped together. |
| Class 5 | Intermediate (Fences approx. 2ft 6" – 2ft 9") |
| Class 6 | Intermediate Pairs Ridden over Intermediate course with Dressing Fences, Show jumping to be jumped separately with one person waiting in a box, then the XC phase will be jumped together. |
| Class 7 | Open (Fences approx 3ft) |

This event is made up of one untimed show jumping round followed immediately by an untimed cross-country course ending with a timed course of show jumps.

Penalties will be added for refusals, run outs and knockdowns etc. (please see rule board by secretary for full list), penalties apply to all phases. Error of course is Elimination.

The winner in each class will be the rider with the least penalties and the fastest time
