

Rules

1. Legal Liability – Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of the event to which these rules apply, nor the British Horse Society, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, vehicle or their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
2. The event is organised in accordance with the Health & Safety Legislation and all who have control of the premises or site at the event are responsible for ensuring that everything reasonably practicable is done to ensure the health and safety and welfare of those attending the event. They conduct themselves to that they do not put themselves or anyone else at risk. Access to and egress from the site is safe. Booklet, if required, stating Health & Safety rules, available at Secretary's tent. Emergency services must have access to all parts of the event site at all times. Any accidents must be reported to the Secretary.
3. *Competitors must be correctly dressed for the event. Hats to new standards EN1384 or PAS015 must be worn at all times when mounted. Hat prefixed with either SEI or ASRM are the American standards and are also acceptable. No fixed peaks. Body/back protectors to current BRC safety standards and medical armbands (to be worn on the arm) are compulsory for the XC. Correct footwear must be worn.*
4. Any competitor jumping or riding over the cross country course or any part thereof except when competing in a cross country event will be asked to leave the field. All entry fees will be forfeited.
5. After three refusals at any one fence, competitors may continue but must go on to the next fence making way for any riders coming up behind, unless asked to leave the course by stewards.
6. Judges' decisions are final and no entry fees will be refunded unless the class is cancelled.
7. Any member of Bath Riding Club Committee, Judge or Steward has the right to ask any rider or persons abusing the use of whip or spurs, using ill fitting or dangerous tack or acting in an offensive manner to leave the field forfeiting all fees.
8. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry, cancel classes, divide or amend any class or restrict the number of entries in any class.
9. No Horse/Pony under the age of 4 years may compete. Horses may be entered in one class only.
10. All dogs must be kept on leads.
11. Parking is on the competition field ONLY. Competitors are asked NOT to park in the private car park adjoining the entrance.
12. Any competitors travelling alone must inform the secretary on arrival.
13. Do not leave horses unattended at the event unless absolutely necessary, in which case contact details for someone at the event must be left clearly displayed on the trailer/horse box.

- Class 1** **Garston Vets Minimus**
Fences up to maximum of 1'9"
Dressage – Walk & Trot Test 2 (Bath RC)
This class is open to all combinations who are not regularly competing or have not been placed at levels above 2'. May be led; if sufficient entries, class may be split into led and non-led sections. Callers allowed for Dressage phase.
- Class 2** **Garston Vets Restricted Novice**
Fences approx 2ft 3" BE 90 Dressage Test 92 (2009)
Present combination not to have been placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in any cross country event (including two phase, hunter trials and ODE). Callers allowed for Dressage phase.
- Class 3** **Garston Vets Open Novice**
Fences approx 2ft 3" BE 90 Dressage test 92 (2009)
Horses not to have competed BE. Run over same course as Class 2 but with some additional and more technical fences. Callers NOT allowed for Dressage phase..
- Class 4** **Garston Vets Intermediate**
Fences approx. 2ft 6" – 2ft 9"
BE 100 Dressage Test 101 (2009)
- Class 5** **Garston Vets Open**
Fences approx. 3ft
BE 100 Dressage Test 101 (2009)

Dressage phase only- Whips are **NOT** allowed and snaffle bridles must be worn. Callers are allowed in Classes 1 & 2 ONLY.

ENTRIES CLOSE Monday 12th September 2011. No entries on the day accepted.

Early entry advised as numbers will be limited; a wait list will be kept.

LATE OR TELEPHONE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

Withdrawals: In the event of any withdrawals, the organisers regret that they cannot refund entry fees after the close of entries
