

## Rules

1. All classes will be run and judged in accordance with the appropriate Rules for British Riding Clubs, a copy of which is available at the Secretary's caravan.
2. Legal Liability – Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are responsible, neither the organisers, nor the B.H.S, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, vehicle or their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
3. The event is organised in accordance with the Health & Safety Legislation and all who have control of the premises or site at the event are responsible for ensuring that everything reasonably practicable is done to ensure the health and safety and welfare of those attending the event. They conduct themselves to that they do not put themselves or anyone else at risk. Access to and egress from the site is safe. Booklet, if required, stating Health & Safety rules, available at Secretary's tent. Emergency services must have access to all parts of the event site at all times.
4. **Correct dress shall be worn. Everyone mounted, whether competitor or not, shall wear a hard hat which is of EN1384, PAS105 or prefixed with ASTM or SEI standard. Such headgear shall be worn properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination. Correct footwear must be worn.**
5. Judges' decisions are final and no entry fees will be refunded unless the class is cancelled.
6. Any member of Bath Riding Club Committee, Judge or Steward has the right to ask any rider or persons abusing the use of whip or spurs, using ill fitting or dangerous tack or acting in an offensive manner to leave the field forfeiting all fees.
7. The organisers reserve the right, in the light of prevailing circumstances to cancel the event, alter classes, judges, time or any other published information.
8. Vet fees incurred at the event are the responsibility of the horse rider or owner.
9. No Horse/Pony under the age of 4 years may compete.
10. All dogs must be kept on leads.
11. Parking is on the competition field ONLY.
12. Please take your rubbish home. Thank You.

**WITHDRAWALS:** In the event of any withdrawals, the organisers regret that they cannot refund entry fees after the close of entries

**BAD WEATHER:** It is the responsibility of the competitors to check with the organiser if weather is inclement.

### Ring 5 - Show Jumping

Rosettes to 6<sup>th</sup> place

Class Entry Fee £7 members £8 non members – Entries may be restricted.

Run under BSJA rules/table A7 (1st round then separate jump off)

Heights shown are 1<sup>st</sup> round heights.

Commencing at 9.30am with clear round £3 or £4 with rosette.

Clear Round may run for a short time between classes

Class 25 Very Novice (Can be Lead) – maximum 1'9"

Not before 10am (Will not go up for the jump off)

Class 26 Open Jumping – 70cm (approx 2'3)

Class 27 Open Jumping – maximum 75cm (approx 2'6)

Class 28 Pairs Jumping – maximum 75cm (approx 2'6)

Jumps max 2'6". Teams of two who compete over the same course. Rider 1 will jump round and pass whip to Rider 2 after jumping the final fence. Rider 2 then jumps the same course. The clock starts from when the first horse jumps fence 1 and stops when the second horse jumps the final fence. Fastest pair wins.

Class 29 Chase me Charlie Jumping – Starts at 75cm

Class 30 Open Jumping – maximum 85cm (approx 2'9)

Class 31 Open Jumping – maximum 95cm (approx 3')
