



## Rules

1. Legal Liability – Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of the event to which these rules apply, nor the British Horse Society, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, vehicle or their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
2. The event is organised in accordance with the Health & Safety Legislation and all who have control of the premises or site at the event are responsible for ensuring that everything reasonably practicable is done to ensure the health and safety and welfare of those attending the event. They conduct themselves to that they do not put themselves or anyone else at risk. Access to and egress from the site is safe. Booklet, if required, stating Health & Safety rules, is available at Secretary's tent. Emergency services must have access to all parts of the event site at all times.
3. **Competitors must be correctly dressed for the event. Hats to new standards EN1384 or PAS015 must be worn at all times when mounted. Hat prefixed with either SEI or ASRM are the American standards and are also acceptable although fixed peak hats are not acceptable for XC. Body/back protectors and medical armbands are compulsory for the event. Correct footwear must be worn.**
4. Any competitor jumping or riding over the cross country course or any part thereof except when competing in a cross country event will be asked to leave the field. All entry fees will be forfeited.
5. After three refusals at any one fence, competitors may continue but must go on to the next fence making way for any riders coming up behind.
6. Judges' decisions are final and no entry fees will be refunded unless the class is cancelled.
7. Any member of Bath Riding Club Committee, Judge or Steward has the right to ask any rider or persons abusing the use of whip or spurs, using ill fitting or dangerous tack or acting in an offensive manner to leave the field forfeiting all fees.
8. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry, cancel classes, divide or amend any class or restrict the number of entries in any class.
9. No Horse/Pony under the age of 4 years may compete.
10. All dogs must be kept on leads.
11. Parking is on the competition field ONLY. Competitors are asked NOT to park in the private car park adjoining the entrance.

### PLEASE TAKE YOUR LITTER HOME

- WITHDRAWALS:** In the event of any withdrawals, the organisers regret that they cannot refund entry fees after the close of entries
- BAD WEATHER:** It is the responsibility of the competitors to check with the organiser if weather is inclement.

<b>Class 2</b>	<b>Intermediate Jumping</b>	Fences approx 2ft 6"
<b>Class 3</b>	<b>Pairs Jumping</b>	Fences approx 2ft 6" One round against the clock

### The following classes will not commence before 1pm

<b>Class 4</b>	<b>Open Jumping</b>	Fences approx 2ft 9"
<b>Class 5</b>	<b>Advanced Jumping</b>	Fences approx 3ft

### Ring 2 - Commencing at 9.00am

**Clear Round** Starting at 1ft 9" approx, raised throughout the day.  
Rosettes to all clear rounds.

### Minimus SJ classes – from approx 12noon - (Table A7)

<b>Class 6 Restricted Novice</b>	Fences approx 1ft 9". May be led. Not to have been placed 1st to 3rd in any jumping competition.
<b>Class 7 Open Novice</b>	Fences approx 2ft". May be led. Not to have won more than £15 in any jumping competition.

### Clear Round SJ will continue after Class 7

**Clear Round Cross Country** **Commencing at 10am**  
All entries taken on the day – **CASH ONLY** – last ticket sold at 3pm.  
Fences range from 2ft 3" to 3ft. Rosettes to all clear rounds

Special rosette to highest placed member not placed 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup>.
